Re: Planning Application for Ballynagare Wind Farm, Co. Kerry

Dear Sir/Madam,

On behalf of our client Ballynagare Wind Farm Limited (the Applicant), please find enclosed a planning application for the construction of a wind energy development and associated works on lands at Ballynagare, approximately 9km west of Listowel and approximately 2km north of Lixnaw, Co. Kerry. The proposal also seeks planning permission for the laying of grid connection cabling in the public road to the site of the existing Clahane 110kV substation. These works will be undertaken by a statutory undertaker having the right and interest to provide the services proposed. Should planning permission be granted for this planning application a separate planning application will seek planning permission for the connection via the private road into the Clahane substation itself. It is confirmed that the underground grid connection route has been assessed as part of the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) which accompanies the planning application.
